- -Creating an end-of-year report on the Collective's performance and suggestions for the direction of the Collective in the future
- \*The coordinator will have a \$500 dollar starting budget, with access to society funding

## Requirements:

- -As the Collective is a closed space for students identifying with disability, you must identify with disability in some way.
- -Basic understanding of social media and Canva
- -Must be a current King's student
- -Some knowledge of the Disability services at King's and Dalhousie

## Assets:

- -Previous experience fostering a community space
- -Knowledge of common areas of support needs and how to accommodate them appropriately

-Openness to learning and adapting within the role

\*Note that while previous experience is definitely an asset, the ideal candidate is simply someone who willing to learn and support students
