2.1 Whereas NSCAD's former president, Dr. Aiofe MacNamara was terminated from her position by the NSCAD Board of Governors on June 28, with suggesting evidence that the decision was done in bad faith; and

Whereas students and faculty members of NSCAD have no confidence in the Board and are demanding the members to step down and for the reinstatement of Dr. MacNamara as their president; and

Whereas the provincial government has openly admitted that Boards of Governors are not accountable to them, therefore threatening the very integrity of their public institutions; and

Whereas there are concerning implications of the government's inaction and refusal of responsibility regarding the management of Boards of Governors; and

Whereas this lack of responsibility may lead to a precedence of negligence that is seen as acceptable; therefore

BIRT the King's Students' Union writes a statement of solidarity with the students of NSCAD, as they continue to fight for accountability and transparency from their Board and the provincial government, as well as the reinstatement of their former president.
